27. Parishioner's Issues

The parish council was asked to consider what role it could play in climate change, including asking for conditions to be imposed on planning consents to mitigate the effects of carbon dioxide in the atmosphere. The Parish Council agreed to consider adding a paragraph to this effect it its responses on planning applications.

The Council were advised that trees from Bunkers Hill would now be ordered for planting as soon as possible.

29. Minutes of the meeting of 13th September 2021

The Council agreed that the minutes of the meeting of the 12th July 2021 were an accurate record of the proceedings except that the "welcome back" party took place on 23rd July, not August 2021.

30. Progress on Parish matters

- a) Speeding traffic
 OCC have just started a "20 is plenty" initiative, which the Council agreed to investigate further.
- b) Srategic Railfreight Interchange(SRFI) The clerk was asked to invite the developers to a meeting with the Parish Council at 7.00pm on 10th January 2022.
- Flooding The items to store materials to mitigate flooding and agreed as part of the resilience grant will be purchased shortly.
- d) Ardley Woods The Parish Council supported the purchase of trees and agreed to cover the costs involved.
- e) Posts by the Church

It has been reported to the Parish Council that posts on the verge by the Church have been knocked over. Cllr killick reported that he had held discussions with OCC and had been advised that OCC would not support the erection of further posts as there was insufficient verge. It was agreed that he should approach OCC again to ask for advice as to suitable verge protection measures.

f) Development of the Fox and Hounds

The site has now been boarded up, but there were concerns expressed that this was blocking sight lines from the Bucknell Road.

g) The Clerk was asked to refer issues of lorries turning round at the B430 road junction to access the waste facility as they have approached from the wrong direction as the access is unidirectional. Councillors were asked to advise the Clerk should this activity be observed. The Clerk was also asked to remind OCC that the Liaison Group needs to be re established.

h) VAS

The posts will shortly be installed, and the device will then be erected.
