19. Parishioner's Issues

A resident attended to ask if the Parish Council would install a dog bin on the post by the gate into the Quarry field, and put a notice by the Church gate reminding people to clean up after their dogs.

There is still concern about the damage to the verge outside the new building in Water Lane. The Clerk will again ask CDC planning to ensure that the verge is reinstated appropriately following completion of the work. There is also a considerable amount of mud on the pavement by the development, which is slippery when wet.

One speed sign on the B430 is hidden by trees and the VAS is not working. The Clerk was asked to report this to OCC.

135 whips are to be planted on 19th November – volunteers required.

A resident suggested that the Parish Council should investigate a jubilee memorial to the late Queen Elizabeth II.

It was reported that the footpath from Water Lane to the White lion is overgrown. The Clerk will refer this to OCC. There is also an overgrown hedge in Water Lane.

22. Progress on Parish matters

- a) Strategic Railfreight Interchange.
 - Ongoing.
- b) Traffic issues and Vas update
 - An application has been made to OCC for consideration of a 20mph speed limit through the Villages of Ardley and Fewcott.
 - The parish is waiting to hear details of the allocation of its s106 monies from CDC. In the meantime the Chair will contact Dave catling of OCC to discuss traffic calming options including a chicane on the Fritwell and Somerton Roads and a 30mph speed limit on the B430.
- c) Defibrillators
 - The Clerk has bought a battery for the defibrillator in Fewcott, which is now in working order.
- d) Viridor
 - Ongoing.
- e) Village Hall/playing field works
 - These have now been completed. The Clerk will request the grant monies from CDC.
- f) MCNP
 - The MCNP is currently being updated and revised.
