NOTICE is given that Oxfordshire County Council proposes to make the above order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers.

The effect of the order - in support of road safety issues - is to introduce a **20mph speed limit** within Ardley (with Fewcott) replacing the existing 30mph speed limit in its entirety, leading out to the following points:

1. Somerton Road:

- a. Western end a point 65 metres west of its junction with Water Lane
- b. Eastern end its junction with the B430
- 2. Fritwell Road a point 580 metres northwest of its junction with Water Lane,
- 3. Church Road its junction with the B430,
- 4. Ardley Road (west of B430) its junction with the B430.

The existing 40mph speed limit will remain on the B430, and Ardley Road (east of the B430) with Officers having taken the current road environment & traffic usage into account.

The Oxfordshire County Council (Ardley Parish) (Speed Limits) Order 2003 will be revoked/replaced as necessary.
